What is hand tufting?

Hand tufting is an age old method by which mattress layers are held together. This process anchors these layers by driving a long needle and tufting straps all the way through the bed. Upholstery layers are pulled together through the spring unit and then bound on each side; then finished with decorative pom-pom or fleurette. Prior to this process taking place, the coil system and comfort layers are compressed. Once tufting is secured, the mattress layers remain taut and stable. Pre-compression limits body impressions and sagging. It also keeps materials from shifting or bunching over time.



Hand tufting - found only on luxury mattresses.

Hand tufting is a labor intensive process that requires skilled craftsmen to complete. This type of workmanship is typically only found in high end, expensive luxury bedding. Hand tufting has been used since the first coil spring mattresses were made. However, most major manufacturers have abandoned this technique in favor of the more cost effective method of gluing layers together.

What are the benefits of hand tufting?

- More uniform and consistent comfort feel
- Limited shifting or bunching of material
- Decreased body impressions and sagging over time
- Better overall support
- · Extended durability and years to the life of your mattress
- Less chemical usage in your mattress

Hand tufting also eliminates some of the excess bounce associated with latex mattresses. In summary, hand tufting adds comfort, support, and durability to your mattress. Take time to explore our full line of hand tufted beds.

For tight budgets, we also offer a one-sided 11" Economy mattress (non-tufted).


